Thank you for your recent correspondence
regarding the Barmouth Viaduct Project and
affording officers from my Authority an
opportunity to learn more about the project.

I understand and appreciate your concerns
regarding the present condition of access to
and from the estuary-end of the Mawddach
Trail into Barmouth. From the conversations
I've held with relevant officers regarding the
project, I can only express our support for a
project which will lead to a safer and more
suitable access point.

In addition to safety and access
considerations, construction of the proposed
viaduct could bring further social and
economic benefits to Barmouth and other
nearby communities – including those within
Snowdonia National Park. Although the site
under consideration is beyond the National
Park boundary, it is inexorably linked to the
popular Mawddach Trail and has informal
linkages to the Arduddy Way; with this being
the case, the Authority would be pleased to
continue its association with the project.

correspondence on the matter.
